### PIGEON ISLAND NATIONAL PARK

Pigeon Island encompasses all of the historical influences of more than a thousand years of human activity. There is Fort Rodney and Signal Hill which were used during the battle between the French and the British for the beautiful island of St. Lucia.

On clear days your view stretches out over the magnificent clear waters of the Caribbean Sea with a backdrop of the island of Martinique.



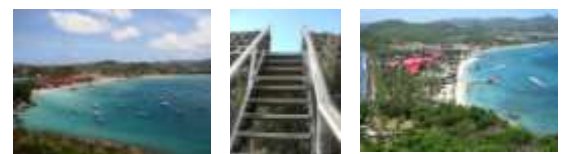
#### II SECLUDED CARIBBEAN BEACH

Imagine having your own secluded beach wedding where you say your vows to each other in a backdrop of palm trees swaying in the warm breeze and the waves gently breaking against the beach. The secluded beach at the Pigeon Island National Park is the only beach that can be hired in St. Lucia. #### III HISTORICAL SITE

Located high on the saddle ridge between the Fort and Signal Peaks you overlook the whole of the Northern half of St. Lucia extending over the Northern Peak, Rodney Bay and Castries and on a clear day the peaks of The World Famous Piton Mountains. The ceremonial area is set within a lawn surrounded by the fresh scent of lemon grass growing around you and the mixed with a fresh tropical breeze.



## IV GAZEBO IN THE PARK

Choose to say your “I Do’s” in serene garden setting surrounded by tropical flora and fauna in the middle of the picturesque National Landmark. The scenery of the garden gazebo in the beautifully maintained park is a perfect setting for a romantic wedding and the park offers a variety of breathtaking locations to take your pictures to remember “your” day!



## WATERFALL

Picture yourselves at the foot of a breathtaking waterfall with the water cascading 50ft over a cliff side, all within the heart of a verdant tropical garden. There are many quaint bridges and walkways that allow you to stroll through the lush greens and dazzling colours of this tropical paradise.



## PLANTATION HOUSE WEDDINGS

### I THE PINK HOUSE

Nestled against a background of giant palm trees, Spanish needles, exotic mango and other fruit trees, stands an imposing structure which has withstood the battles of time. Erected over a century ago, St. Edmunds, affectionately called “the Pink House”, because of its rosy hue, is a two storey timber house perched on 31,040 square feet of land located near the winding base of Morne Fortune.

The views from the Morne are so extraordinary, that they stretch over lush and vibrant country side. Deep calm Caribbean seas, stretching past a bird’s eye view of the harbour, the City of Castries and even as far as Pigeon Point, the northern most peak of St. Lucia.



### II SUGAR MILL

Set within the Invergoil Estate, this wonderful historical site is a 400-acre estate in the village of Anse La Raye. La Sikwi features a 40ft water wheel which dates back to the sugar growing years of the 18th Century. You could choose to either be married inside the rustic and tranquil setting of the Sugar Mill or within the beautiful garden, filled with colorful tropical flora which surrounds the Sugar Mill, either of which makes a wonderful backdrop for your ceremony.



## CHURCH WEDDINGS

St. Lucia has beautiful churches some of which are located in small fishing villages along the coast. In order to recommend a church we need to know the denomination of the church you are both in and will then require an official letter from your religious officiate to the corresponding officiate in St. Lucia. Most churches require that you have undergone pre-marriage counselling from your regular religious leader.

## THE PITON MOUNTAIN BACKDROP
